## Prosper Fire Department holds badge pinning ceremony

PROSPER (November 22, 2010) Two officials of the Prosper Fire Department will undergo the tradition of having their official badges, denoting their position in the department, pinned on their formal uniforms, a ceremony that has its roots in similar rituals going back several centuries to the establishment of fire brigades, according to Prosper Fire Chief Ronnie Tucker.

Assistant Fire Chief Curtis Smith and Fire Marshal Bryan Ausenbaugh will officially be pinned on Tuesday, November 30, 2010 at ceremonies taking place at the Central Fire Station, 1500 East First Street starting at 1 p.m.

The public is invited to attend and take part in the solemn observance and remain afterward for a small reception.
