## Library to close for Easter, open late during TAKS days

PROSPER (April 20, 2011) The Prosper Community Library will be closed for the Easter holiday weekend, starting on Friday, April 22 through Sunday April 24, according to Librarian Linda Shaw.

Then, following a regular schedule on Monday, April 25, the Library will open at 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 26 through Thursday, April 28. Some of the students at Reynolds Middle School, where the library is co-located, will be taking their state-mandated TAKS tests. School policy and state regulations require that during TAKS testing, the school is closed to outside visitors.

The Library will be closed completely on Friday, April 29.

Regular operating hours will resume Saturday, April 30, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.

“The Prosper Community Library appreciates your patience during this period,” said Shaw.
