Burn Ban

Denton County has lifted their burn ban and therefore, the PROSPER FIRE MARSHAL has followed suit and lifted the burn restrictions for the areas of Prosper that fall within Denton County.

*NOTE- This does not apply to Collin County. The burn ban still remains in effect for the Town of Prosper that is located within Collin County. It is not uncommon for a Town/City to adopt the same rules of whatever county they are located in.

All ground supported fires are prohibited with the exception of firefighter training, public utility and natural gas pipeline operations, and burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under the Natural Resources Code. The ban does not include the use of grills, smokers, approved non-combustible burn pits, outdoor fire places, or similar devices as long as the open flame, embers, and coals are contained in an approved device intended for that particular use.
