

Frontier Park North

Staff continues to evaluate artificial turf options. A Request for Proposals (RFP) is being developed to send out for competitive bids of a turn-key artificial turf installation. Designs are 50% complete. The Construction Manager-at-Risk is estimated to give a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) in mid October, with construction to begin by the end of the year.



Preston Lakes Park



Design is underway, with an estimated completion date of August 2016. Estimated construction completion date is March 2017.

PARK OPERATIONS

Frontier Park

Laid sod at softball and baseball area; aerified and top-dressed all sports fields; serviced AC units at concessions; pre-emergent spraying for weeds at Windmill Park/pavilion; brought in 2 tons of DG for the ballfields; added the clay bricks to all home plates and pitching mounds; baseball season has ended.

General

Job Corps started painting the pipe fencing and carpentry work on the pavilion at Town Lake and also Whispering Farms.
