Frontier Park North Field Improvements

At the April 26, 2016, Town Council meeting, Council added a lacrosse wall, bullpens, and additional parking. The estimated cost of development is \$9,751,225. The CMAR agreement with Dean Construction was also approved at the meeting. Staff continues to evaluate artificial turf options and develop a Request for Proposals (RFP) to send out for competitive bids on a turn-key artificial turf installation.


