


Library Card Use

A library card in good standing allows:


- 20 items checked out at a time; Books, CDs, DVDs/BluRays, and Audiobooks.
- The lending period for all items is 2 weeks.
- Item renewals may be done via logging into your library account and renewing the item(s) by the original due date.
 - Only one renewal per item is allowed.
 - Items for which a hold has been placed may not be renewed.
 - Items that are overdue may not be renewed online.
 - Kits may not be renewed.
- Holds may be requested for unavailable items as well as items on our shelves via logging into your library account, searching for the item, and placing the hold; 10-item limit per card.
 - Patrons will receive an email alerting them the hold is ready.
- Priority entrance to popular programs in which an attendance cap is utilized.
- Hotspot devices are available for patrons under the following guidelines:
 - Hotspots may be borrowed for two weeks and renewed one time in person or over the phone.
 - Hotspots must be returned in person to the Circulation Desk, and never to another library, left outside the library door, or in the book drop
 - Hotspots are not intended to be a long-term internet solution.
 - Hotspots are not eligible to be checked out to any account in the same household for 30 days after the system check-in date.
- Members are not assessed fees for overdue items. However, after 21-days, items are considered lost and the billing process is initiated.
- Patrons may not independently purchase items to replace a lost or damaged item.
- Members are financially responsible for lost or damaged items on their account, as well as, any damage to equipment and/or library property while visiting the library.


eBooks & Audiobooks

Prosper Community Library offers patrons two digital library options; Libby and cloudLibrary. Download the apps today to explore the thousands of titles that are available for you to check out and read on your mobile device(s).



Our catalog, **Aspen** and its companion app, **LiDA**, searches our physical collection and both **Libby** and **cloudLibrary** when you are searching for your next great read. Patrons can place holds and check out titles directly from our catalog. However, you will need the Libby or cloudLibrary apps to read titles borrowed from their respective collection. Each service will specify the type of devices that are compatible with each title.

Borrowed titles will be automatically returned at the end of the lending period but may be returned early if desired.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

Children under 12 must be accompanied by and visually supervised by the adult with whom they came.

Running, climbing, and being loud are not allowed and may result in the adult being asked to remove the child until behaviour is appropriate for the library.

Children under 18 may have their own library card that is linked to a parent or guardian's adult account. The parent or guardian assumes full financial responsibility for items checked out to their children's cards.



Programs & Resources

Our library is so much more than a building full of books. We offer a wide array of fiction and non-fiction titles for all ages, digital and electronic/cloud titles, literacy-based kits, movies, public computers, and a plethora of programs and online resources, such as Mango Languages™, LinkedIn Learning™, and TexShare Databases™ for free to our patrons. In addition, we also offer fee-based 3D printing, copying, printing and scanning services, as well as, Interlibrary Loan Services.

Membership

Library membership is solely based on the patron's permanent place of residence as directed by Prosper's Town Council. Residents who pay the CPR/C48 (Prosper Town) tax are eligible for a free membership which must be renewed every two years. Parents may obtain library cards for their minor children regardless of age. Those who do not pay a Town of Prosper Utility Bill nor the CPR/C48 (Prosper Town) tax may purchase a library membership for \$50 per card which may be renewed annually.
