Through a strategic partnership with the Flock Safety Program, the Prosper community now has the opportunity to actively contribute to law enforcement efforts by registering their security cameras with the [Prosper C.A.T.C.H. Program](#). By adding cameras to the designated registry, community members enable the PPD to swiftly locate potential video evidence pertinent to ongoing criminal investigations. This streamlined process facilitates prompt access to crucial information, significantly expediting the apprehension of suspects and resolution of cases.

Participants in the program have the option to integrate their camera systems with the Flock Safety Program, granting first responders access to live footage in emergency situations. This invaluable feature ensures that law enforcement can rapidly assess unfolding events, enabling more effective response strategies and ultimately safeguarding lives and property within the community.
