Safety Tips

DO:

- Wear gloves and thick-soled, closed toe shoes
- Wear long pants and long sleeve shirt
- Wear safety vests provided in your cleanup supply kit
- Wear sunscreen and bug repellent
- Bring and drink plenty of water
- Be aware of your surroundings and potential hazards (passing cars, hazardous tree branches, poison ivy, snakes, etc.)
- Use the “buddy system”. Work in teams to maximize safety
- Wash hands with antibacterial soap after cleanup and use hand sanitizer provided in your cleanup supply kit.
- Stop your cleanup event if hazardous conditions are present (bad weather, traffic, etc.)

DON'T:

- Wear Pick up hazardous materials such as hypodermic needles, sharp objects, hazardous waste, animal carcasses, or any other unidentified or questionable object. Immediately report to Prosper Public Works.
- Attempt to move large or heavy objects. Immediately report to Prosper Public Works.
- Perform any activities outside of your physical abilities.
- Allow minors to participate in cleanup events without adult supervision.
- Conduct cleanup near or around active construction sites. Please alert Program Coordinator with any concerns.
- Schedule cleanups during peak pedestrian or traffic hours.
- Conduct cleanups during inclement weather (rain, snow, hottest part of day)
