



Adopt-A-Street Program

The Town of Prosper **Adopt-A-Street Program** provides individuals, civic organizations, and others with an opportunity to help beautify our community by volunteering their time to collect litter alongside Prosper roadways.

Program Requirements

Adoptees must conduct a minimum of 4 cleans a year to remain in the program. One clean-up per quarter as listed below:

1. **January 1st - March 31st**
2. **April 1st - June 30th**
3. **July 1st - September 30th**
4. **October 1st - December 31st**

- Adoptees agree to maintain the adopted street including any attached sidewalks and curbs for one year. Contracts will be automatically renewed for those in good standing.
- Adoptees will need to complete one clean-up before their Adopt-A-Street sign(s) will be ordered and installed.
- If picking up a kit, adoptees need to submit a **Schedule a Clean-up form** no more than 1 week in advance.

*Note: Supply kits will include up to 15 safety vests.

- After a clean-up is completed, Public Works will collect trash bags (during operating hours) that are placed by the adoptees sign only if notified to do so. Adoptees can also dispose of trash themselves if they prefer.
- Adoptees will return clean-up kits no more than a week after a clean-up is conducted to ensure there are enough supplies on hand for other groups.
- After a clean-up is completed, adoptees will submit an **After Clean-up Report** which can be done by scanning the QR code on the clean-up kit. This helps us track the positive impact this program has on our community!

Adopt-A-Street Program

If a quarterly clean-up is missed, two cleans must be conducted within the next quarter to remain active in the program.

Clean-up kit contents:

- Trash grabbers (can provide up to 15 upon request)
- Trash bags
- Sanitizer
- Gloves
- Safety vests (up to 15)

After completing the first cleanup, if the adoptee decides to continue with their street, two signs will be ordered and placed - one on each side of the street. Street lengths vary, with most stretching close to a mile in one direction.

Adopt-a-Street Program Terms & Adoption Agreement

It is agreed by all parties that if the maintenance of the contracted area is not being performed according to the terms agreed upon, the Town has the ability to end the contract. When a team is behind in their cleanups, they will receive a 30-day notice to conduct a clean-up to remain in the program. Teams who receive a second late notice will have 10 days to resume maintenance and submit forms or be removed from the program.

Release Signatures (Hold Harmless)

Must be agreed to and received by Prosper Public Works before each scheduled clean-up event. In consideration of the Town of Prosper's acceptance of my participation in the above project, I, for myself, participating in the project, any heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever releases and discharges any and all rights, demands, claims and causes of suit of action, known or unknown, whether arising now or in the future, that I may have against the Town of Prosper and any and all injuries, including death and property damage in any manner arising or resulting from my participation in said project. I attest and verify that I have full knowledge of the risks involved in the project, that I solely assume those risks, that I will, without limitation, assume and pay any medical and emergency expenses in the event of an accident, injury, illness or other incapacity, regardless of whether I have authorized such expenses. Furthermore, I state that I have carefully read this release, know the contents of the release and sign the release of my own free will.
