

Informal meeting to discuss the project, planned construction activities, and a chance for you to ask questions.



Reasons for Construction:

- ❖ Redoing the asphalt would be over \$1M and would still require ongoing maintenance and pothole patching
- ❖ Concrete street provides for a longer life before major maintenance is required
- ❖ On the Town's thoroughfare plan as a four-lane divided roadway; however, existing two-lane configuration is able to handle current traffic conditions
- ❖ Constructing only two of the ultimate 4-lanes, allows the Town to improve the roadway, maintain a quality level of service, and the ability to stretch the Town's resources to fund other needed projects.



Construction Scope:

- ❖ Improve the existing two-lane rural asphalt roadway to two-lanes of an ultimate four-lane divided suburban concrete arterial roadway.

Including:

- ❖ Concrete curbs and gutters
- ❖ Underground drainage improvements along the southern portion, additional improvements will be included when future lanes are constructed
- ❖ Construction of concrete sidewalk/trail near the intersections with Coit Road and Custer Road

Project Schedule

- ❖ Franchise utility relocations will begin in the near future
- ❖ The Town is currently working with property owners to acquire necessary right-of-way and easement
- ❖ Roadway construction is anticipated to begin late Summer 2020 and be completed in late Fall 2021

Project Cost



- ❖ Engineer's estimate is \$6.22 Million

Minor Thoroughfare '4LD' (Midblock)





Typical Prosper Trail Cross Section








Approximate locations shown

- ❖ How do I handle getting something repaired I believe was damaged due to construction activities?




