

Adopt-A-Street

Mission:

The Adopt-A-Street Program delivers a terrific opportunity to teach the importance of citizenship and improve our community while providing teams of all kinds with an opportunity to help beautify the community by volunteering to collect litter alongside Prosper streets.

Purpose:

- ⇒ It's a simple way for groups to help the community.
- ⇒ It visibly improves, protects, and preserves our local environment.
- ⇒ It creates pride amongst our teams and community.
- ⇒ It reduces litter clean-up costs and saves tax payer money.

Requirements:

- ⇒ Teams must agree to maintain their adopted street, in both directions, for one year. Contracts are automatically renewed upon good standing.
- ⇒ Prior to conducting a cleanup, teams must request supplies and schedule their cleanups through Public Works.
- ⇒ Teams must complete five required cleanups a year. These cleanups include four quarterly cleanups and one Earth Month Cleanup in the month of April.
 - ◇ 1st Quarter Cleanup—January 1 - March 31
 - ◇ Earth Month Cleanup—April 1 - 30
 - ◇ 2nd Quarter Cleanup—May 1 - June 30
 - ◇ 3rd Quarter Cleanup—July 1 - September 30
 - ◇ 4th Quarter Cleanup—October 1 - December 31

Support:

- ⇒ Installation of "Adopt-A-Street" sign with entities name.
- ⇒ Supplies needed to conduct clean up may be picked up from 601 W Fifth Street in Prosper.
- ⇒ Recognition of service to community via social media and resident update.
