



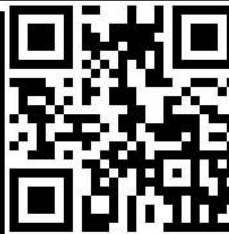
# Community Emergency Response Team TOWN OF PROSPER CERT Training

Upon submission of the online final test certificate of achievement, the Town of Prosper Volunteer Release form and background check, you will be registered to attend the Hands-on, practical portion of the CERT training. Upon successful completion of all Hands-on training, you will receive a CERT Certificate and if you are a Prosper resident, will be able to join the Town of Prosper CERT program. **Deadline to submit your instructional online certificate is August 31st.** Space is limited for the hands-on training. Once you have met all the requirements for attending the hands-on training, you will be notified if you have a reserved seat, or if you are waitlisted.
