



Update on Parking at Frontier Park for the Spring 2018 Sports Season February 2, 2018

Frontier Park North will be ready for games this spring! We will soon enjoy new athletic fields that will be a terrific addition to our youth sports programs. Adjacent to Frontier Park, construction is also underway on the Prosper ISD (PISD) stadium and natatorium, slated to open prior to the 2019 football season. Exciting projects are in the making! Each brings with it lasting advantages and temporary challenges.

The construction, combined with the removal of the park's east-side gravel parking lot, will result in limited parking and traffic congestion at Frontier Park throughout Spring 2018. The sports leagues, Town of Prosper and PISD have worked together for months seeking solutions and alternatives to address the impending parking issues.

The Prosper Youth Sports Commission and the Boards of Directors for each sport are looking at temporary adjustments to operations, which may include playing more games Friday nights; playing later on Saturdays; increasing time between games; altering field usage; and playing some games at Eagles Landing.

The Town and PISD have agreed to share parking, once complete, between the park and stadium when needed. PISD is working with the Town to schedule construction activities that are least disruptive for park participants, yet do not hinder construction nor timelines. District officials have emphasized to the contractor the importance of constructing driveways and parking spaces as soon as is feasible.

No doubt, things will be different this spring, yet these adjustments should help. Please remember parking will continue to be impacted throughout the spring season, especially at peak times. Prosper is a special place where people work together to find solutions that benefit the community. The cooperation between the Town, PISD and the leagues has resulted in workable solutions. We are all optimistic this will be a short term problem and a permanent solution is within sight.

Thank you in advanced to everyone for your patience during this expansion and construction period. Please stay tuned for league-specific communications with further guidance and assistance for the parking situation this spring.
