IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARDS

If any of the following conditions exist, a food establishment should close voluntarily and contact the Health & Code Compliance Division immediately for a site assessment.

- Lack of potable water
- Inadequate amount of refrigeration
- Sewage back-up
- Lack of sanitation, which is defined as a score of a 69 or below on an inspection
- Lack of hot water
- Extended interruption of electrical water
- Misuse of poisonous/toxic chemicals
- On-set of an apparent food-borne disease outbreak
- Other conditions which may affect public health
- Non-compliance issue: any violation documented on three (3) consecutive inspections, will require a follow-up inspection within 48 hours

Failure to report imminent health hazards may result in citation(s) issued, fees assessed, and/or closure of the establishment until re-inspected and approved by the Health Authority.
