Non-emergency offices close for holidays

To celebrate and memorialize our nation's official birth, the Town of Prosper will close its offices on Tuesday, July 4. This one-day closure allows administrative employees the opportunity to commemorate the day with their loved ones.

All non-emergency offices will be closed on July 4, but will reopen on Wednesday, July 5. Similarly, offices will close on Sept. 4 to celebrate Labor Day. As customary, offices will reopen on Tuesday, Sept. 5.

Fire, Police and EMS service will be provided as usual, with no disruption of their 24-hour schedule. Operators in the Dispatch office will also be on hand to assist with any emergencies.

We wish everyone a safe and restful Independence Day and Labor Day holidays.

Trash and recycling undergo holiday shift

First Monday bulk trash pickup changes in September

Trash and recycling collection by the Town's solid waste contractor, Waste Connections, will be affected by the Independence Day and Labor Day holidays.

Both of these days fall during the first week of their respective months. While July's first Monday bulk trash pickup is not affected, the bulk trash pickup for the first Monday in September will be affected. First Monday residents are those who live between the western Town limits and Teel Parkway.

As usual, regularly scheduled trash and recycling pickup will undergo the holiday shift for both weeks.




